**STREET COLLECTIONS 2012**

**1. Purpose**

- 1.1 To ask Members to approve the allocation of Street Collection Permits for 2012.

**2. Recommendation**

- 2.1 It is recommended that permits be allocated in accordance with **APPENDIX 'A'**.

**3. Summary of Background Information**

- 3.1 In accordance with Council policy, the allocation of permits for all charitable organisations applying is split between the City of Lichfield and the Parish of Burntwood. Organisations are rotated each year, so if a charity is given a permit for Lichfield one year, it is given a permit for Burntwood the following year. An exception has been made for those organisations whose fundraising activities are concentrated in one area.
- 3.2 Lichfield Greenhill Bower and Lichfield Round Table (Christmas collection) are allocated Street Collection Permits for the City of Lichfield each year. In addition the National Poppy Appeal is allocated a permit to enable the sale of poppies throughout the District.

**4. Financial Implications**

- 4.1 There will be no direct financial implications for the Council. Street Collections are an important source of income for the organisations that apply for permits.
