Thanks Adam – just to confirm then, does this mean you're happy with the suggested conditions? If you can confirm that I will let Licensing know and they can be applied to the licence.

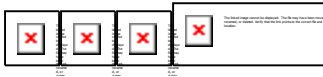

Thank you for getting everything over to me just to confirm all the conditions. I know we have already spoken about it all in our meeting and everything has been done our end to comply with the new restrictions.

Hello Russell,

As you know, further to our discussions earlier in the year, we are proposing to apply the same conditions for noise as existed last year but with an additional one for the bass frequencies. The conditions are therefore as follows:

1. *All amplified music in an outside marquee or in the open air shall finish no later than 23:00 hours on each day.*

2. *Music from the event is permitted only between the following hours:*

Friday 25th August: 16:00 to 23:00

Saturday 26th August: 12:00 to 23:00

Sunday 27th August: 11:00 to 23:00

3. *At least 7 days prior to the commencement of licensed activities a Noise Management Plan shall be submitted to Lichfield District Council outlining the noise controls that will be taken to ensure noise Conditions 4 to 12 are adhered to.*

4. *The Music Noise Level (MNL) expressed as a 15 minute LAeq shall not exceed 65dBA taken as a free field measurement at locations agreed with Environmental Health Officer and detailed in the Noise Management Plan referred to in Condition 3.*

5. *The Music Noise Level (MNL) in either of the 63Hz or 125Hz octave frequency bands expressed as a 15 minute LAeq shall not exceed 70dBA taken as a free field measurement at locations agreed with Environmental Health Officer and detailed in the Noise Management Plan referred to in Condition 3.*

6. *Loudspeakers must be orientated such that they face a west, away from noise sensitive premises.*

7. *Noise limiters/compressors shall be used for all stages that sets a maximum volume for the music to ensure it does not exceed the MNL limits referred to in Conditions 4 and 5 above. Details of any noise limiters/compressors shall be provided in the Noise Management Plan referred to in Condition 3.*

8. *A sound check shall be carried out prior to the event, after 10:00 hours, to ensure that the sound levels at the agreed monitoring positions outlined in the aforementioned Noise Management Plan are as expected, taking into account the weather conditions on the day. If the agreed sound levels at the sound desk need to be adjusted this shall be done, the levels noted and checks made to ensure further adjustments are prevented.*

9. *During the event, the organiser shall operate an attended noise complaint telephone line through which contact can be made regarding noise concerns. This phone number shall be publicised in advance of the event to the surrounding communities and in a manner to be agreed with the Licensing Authority. The contact number shall also be provided to the Environmental Health team at Lichfield District Council should noise levels be considered unacceptable during the event.*

10. *A team of marshals shall be employed for the event to ensure people enter and leave the site at the designated points of entry/exit in a respectful manner to prevent public nuisance.*

11. *Officers from the Responsible Authority for Environmental Health (Environmental Protection) will monitor the event. You must therefore ensure cooperation and unrestricted access to the front of house position and backstage areas at all times to the Responsible Authority for Environmental Health (Environmental Protection) for the purpose of sound level measurements, communications with sound technicians/engineers, event organiser/supervisor(s) and for monitoring licence conditions.*

12. *The event organisers shall ensure bands/performers/DJs booked to appear, as well as all sound technicians/engineers are aware of the need to be sensitive to potential noise problems and shall accept the restrictions that may be imposed upon them, including the noise conditions set out here.*

The attached map gives details of the x5 locations we would expect the noise monitoring positions to be located. This indicates the locations of complaints from 2022 as well as the nearest and most likely to be affected areas.

If you're happy with the above please let me know and I will confirm with Licensing. The above is non-negotiable as far as we are concerned unless you have proposals to reduce noise more than these conditions require, which seems unlikely. If you're not happy with these conditions please do let me know as soon as possible because a Licensing Hearing will have to be arranged.
